Vineyard Info:

Peters Vineyard sits a few miles southwest of Sebastopol on Elphick Road, an ideal location for Pinot Noir. Not far from the Sonoma Coast, this former Gravenstein apple orchard is blanketed by cool ocean fog in the mornings and evenings. The warm sunny days intensify the fruit, helping to create the flavor profile we seek. The four clones that make up this vineyard are Pommard, 777, 115, and 2A.

Winemaker Notes:

On the nose, this fresh and lively Pinot Noir exhibits aromas of Bing cherry and strawberry preserves. A sensual mid-palate full of rich spicy goodness and bright acidity transitions into a joyous, blissful finish. Pairs perfectly with pulled pork or plank-grilled salmon steaks.
