


CHENOWETH VINEYARDS

Vineyard Info:

Two iconic Green Valley vineyards farmed by the Chenoweth Family make up this wine. The region's cool climate combined with the local Gold Ridge Sandy Loam soil leads to extended hang times and the ideal amount of stress to produce world-class Pinot Noir grapes less than 10 miles from the Pacific Ocean.

Winemaker Notes:

This Green Valley beauty tantalizes your nose with explosive aromatics. The essence of dark fruit envelops the glass while a touch of bing cherry delights ever so softly. This complex yet balanced Pinot Noir will leave your palate with an earthy finish not always found in such a delicate fruit.

History of Sedition

Sedition is the culmination of a 20-year friendship grounded in midwestern roots with the goal of turning Sonoma County's most elite Pinot Noir grapes into a wine worthy of its heritage. The minimalistic winemaking approach allows the quality of the fruit to highlight the hard work of the farmers in the field.
