Vineyard Info:

This eastern Sonoma County vineyard was badly affected by the 2017 Tubbs fire. We were able to harvest a few tons of grapes just days before the fire started but ended up losing about 80% of these grapes that year. This vintage is the least amount of Cabernet we have ever produced.

Winemaker Notes:

This classically styled Cabernet Sauvignon is structurally balanced with a rugged minerality. A hint of chocolate surprises your palate before dissolving into a velvety mouthfeel. A smooth finish allows for a perfect pairing with any assortment of grilled meats and veggies.
